Each of our NERA stations will have an opportunity to ring in on the agInnovation assessment and budget during the week November 27.

- agInnovation's Diversity Catalyst Committee is hosting a webinar on November 16 at 4:00 PM ET titled **A Lived Experience: Tribal Relations and Natural Resource Stewardship**. The webinar will be presented by <u>Jennifer Ballinger</u>, a Tribal Relations Specialist with the Forest Service. <u>Registration</u> is free and all are invited!
- The National Academies is seeking suggestions for experts to participate in a new study on platforms that support collaboration on high-quality science, education, and extension among land-grant institutions, especially those that support the active participation of historically Black colleges and universities and Tribal colleges, along with non-land grant partners. The deadline for submitting nominations is November 10, 2023. This is a follow-on to the NASEM effort in 2022, Enhancing Coordination and Collaboration Across the Land-Grant System.
- The <u>Specialty Crop Research Initiative</u> (SCRI) <u>Request for Pre-Applications</u> is out. The closing date for the program is December 8, 2023, and there is \$75,440,000 in estimated funding.
- Sara Delheimer has shared the <u>Multistate Research Fund Impacts Communications Themes for November</u>. Please share those themes with your communicators.
- The National Science Foundation is hosting their <u>Virtual Grants Conference</u> December 4-7, 2023. Registration is free and opens on Wednesday November 8 at 12 PM ET. (As a heads up, there's a link
